The variety and abundance of technologies and communication channels raises many questions for education: What and how to teach? How much technology should be included in the educational process? How to engage learners? How to prepare children and young people for the future? How to develop personality? How to communicate? The changing economic, technological, and social environment is leading to a transformation from a knowledge-based to a creative society, where the role and relevance of knowledge are being rethought and critical thinking is being updated. In 2020, a pandemic has paralysed the world, bringing with it a bundle of challenges requiring lightning-fast solutions, without being able to resolve, at either international or national level, the perplexities posed by a changing environment. This period has given everyone the opportunity to rethink their values, their priorities, their activities, and their lives, to test their capacity to learn and change quickly, to reflect, and to act adaptively. While the pandemic was still unfolding, society was confronted with geopolitical tensions and the threat of a world war. These circumstances add to and adjust the set of challenges facing education. Generational theorists argue that the basis of human communication is a system of values that is formed before the age of five.

The rapidly changing social and technological context calls for a rethinking of the value foundations, orientations, and communication strategies of education. We have to operate in an environment we do not know. We have to work with a generation that is called the natives of the virtual world. We need to apply technologies that we have seen in fictional films. We do not know today where, how, and with whom we will have to work tomorrow. The educational community is in a state of uncertainty. And it is more important than ever to learn the lessons of the past so that we can discover the focus of tomorrow.

At the conference, we will examine the phenomenon of uncertainty in education and the challenges of communication at the intersection of the past and the future. We will discuss in support of each other, strengthening the community that is so necessary in an age of uncertainty.

**The first day of the conference** (17 October) is devoted to plenary announcements, scientific discussions and other general activities. The work will take place at the Faculty of Creative Industries of Vilnius Gediminas Technical University (1 Trakų St., 01132 Vilnius). Exhibitions and excursions await during breaks.
